Fridays have an earlier lunch at 12:30

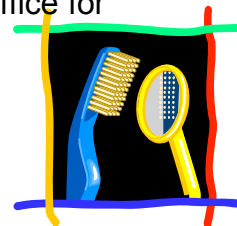
School dismisses at 2.15pm on the last day of each term.

# School Dental Service

The School Dental Service, a branch of the Dental Health Services of the South Australian Health Commission, provides general dental care to primary and pre-school children. Dental care is provided periodically, according to children's needs. Emphasis is placed on the prevention of dental disease through treatment procedures and diet.

Our nearest Dental Clinic is based at either Birdwood Primary School or Mount Barker Primary School.

If you are not already enrolled at the clinic, or have transferred from another school, please contact the school office for registration forms.



# School Rules

We do not have many school rules and those we do have relate to the safety and protection of our students so they can learn and play in a safe and caring environment.

At the beginning of the year, all classes discuss rules appropriate to their own classrooms. We emphasise respect for self and others, the school buildings and resources and their own belongings. We ask children to take responsibility for their behaviour and actions. **We expect students to follow instructions or directions given by staff without argument or delay.**

If students cannot follow instructions or play or work safely they will be excluded from the classroom or playground.

**We expect all students to speak and behave in a courteous and considerate way to everyone they come in contact with.**

Parents will be informed when their child has not followed school rules either by a note in their diary or by a phone call or by the teacher talking directly to the parent before or after school.

A list of unacceptable behaviours and their consequences is in every classroom and on the website.
