Transition to High School

Our students attend a variety of High Schools both public and private. Our two local high schools are Oakbank Area School and Birdwood High School, entry is decided firstly by postcode. They also apply for entry to specialist programs such as basket ball at Heathfield High School, the Ignite program at Glenunga High and the agricultural focus at Urrbrae High School. We ensure that students are able to attend transition days and are prepared for this next step.



Year 7 Graduation Dinner

At the end of term 4 the Year 6 students and parents plan a dinner for the Year 7 students and their parents. This dinner is prepared, cooked and served in school. It is a beautiful evening and marks the Year 7's leaving and the stepping up of the Year 6's to their new role as Student Leaders.



Special Programs

To assist Year 7 students with their preparation for High School, we run a variety of special programs. In even years all year 6/7 students undertake a 6 hour First Aid Course including CPR. Whenever possible our year 7's take part in programs such as Kids in the Kitchen. In odd years, they take part in an aquatics camp on the Murray. Senior students can plan and lead whole school excursions, with adult supervision. In even years senior students spend a week in Canberra with students from other schools.
