

Custody Orders

The Principal must sight a copy of custody orders and access arrangements if and when it is applicable to a child enrolled or enrolling at the school.



Daily Physical Exercise

All students have at least 4 sessions of physical exercise a week. We encourage everyone to participate in a positive manner. Children can be excused from PE for health reasons if a note is sent from home. Children with asthma are encouraged to participate to a level that is safe and comfortable for them.

Decision Making

We are committed to active participation by staff, parents and students in the decision-making process. Students have weekly SRC meetings to feed information, ideas and requests to the staff and parent committees as appropriate. The staff and parent body have various meetings and committees as required and parents are welcomed and encouraged to take part at this level of school support and decision-making. Surveys are sent out to the Parent body on a regular basis. Groups include the Governing Council, the Building Committee, Parents and Friends Group and other groups are formed when needed.

The Principal ensures decisions do not contravene DECD policies and regulations before implementing and informing the community about them.
