Behaviour Management

We believe children should be taught to take responsibility for their behaviour and act accordingly. All students are expected to follow the instructions they are given, treat themselves, others and the school with courtesy and respect.

All staff work together to manage any behaviour issues - they are not the concern of just one teacher.

A list of unacceptable behaviour and their consequences can be found in every student's diary. Parents will be kept informed through notes or direct contact, as per our policy.

We ask that parents keep teachers informed of incidents of harassment and bullying.

All teachers provide parents with a contact number and email address which parents are encouraged to use if they have any concerns.

Bicycles

Riding bicycles to and from school requires great care because of the dangerous nature of the surrounding roads. Correct fitting helmets must always be worn. The school does its best to reinforce this message, but strong parent support is also necessary. We encourage all bike riders to wear high visibility jackets for added safety.

Bike racks behind the sandpit are available for children to use. Bicycles are not to be ridden in the school grounds during school hours.
