

Decision Making

We are committed to active participation by staff, parents and students in the decision making process. Students have weekly SRC meetings to feed information, ideas and requests to the staff and parent committees as appropriate. The staff and parent body have various meetings and committees as required and parents are welcomed and encouraged to take part at this level of school support and decision making. Surveys are sent out to the parent body as required.

Groups include the Governing Council, Parents and Friends Group and other groups are formed when needed.

The Principal ensures decisions do not contravene Department for Education policies and regulations before implementing and informing the community about them.

Emergencies

Evacuation

An evacuation is when the siren rings to warn staff and students that there is an emergency such as a fire in one of the buildings. Everyone will move out to the oval.

Invacuation

An invacuation is when the siren rings to warn staff and students that there is an emergency such as a bushfire, a snake or other dangerous situation outside the buildings. Everyone will move into the main building.
